In this 90-minute interactive workshop, participants will explore advocacy as it relates to the promotion, sustainability, and expansion of school meals programs. We will explore a real-world advocacy success story and identify the key parts of a successful campaign. Working with regional partners, participants will have the opportunity to practice using data from the Global Survey Country Reports to inform the development of an advocacy plan.
